

2024 Reno County Fair Livestock Sale Scholarship Application

This application is to be used for the Reno County Fair Livestock Sale Scholarship. **All applications are due to the Reno County Extension Office by 5:00 P.M. on March 18, 2024.** Applicant must be a senior in high school or a freshman in college, currently a 4-H or FFA member and active in 4-H or FFA through their last year of 4-H/FFA eligibility. They must have a minimum of four years participation in the market livestock program and sale. Selection is based on current 4-H/FFA participation, leadership, and community involvement. Applicant may only receive the scholarship once.

INSTRUCTIONS:

The following **MUST** be attached to this form:

- **4-H/FFA Story**

A minimum of one-to-two-page document which gives a summary of your participation in 4-H/FFA written in 12 pt font single spaced. Do not make a list, tell your story.

- **A letter of recommendation from a current or past Community Leader in your Club or FFA Chapter**

It should address the following:

- a. Examples of Club and Countywide leadership
- b. Please speak to the character of the applicant
- c. Any information you would like to share with the selection committee
